

DRIVERS SAFETY COURSE INFORMATION

You may require that one (1) charge be dismissed by taking a Drivers Safety Course (DSC). HOWEVER, YOU LOSE THAT RIGHT IF YOU FAIL TO PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE COURT ON OR BEFORE YOUR APPEARANCE DATE of your desire to do so. (If Eligible)

YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE IF:

1. You do not hold a valid Texas Drivers License
2. You have had a Drivers Safety Course for the dismissal of a traffic charge within the last 12 MONTHS
3. You were cited for speeding and the alleged speed was 25 MPH or more over the posted limit
4. The Vehicle you were driving was not covered by Liability Insurance
5. You were charged with a traffic violation while holding a commercial motor vehicle drivers license.
6. You were involved in an accident with damage to vehicle.

IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE, YOU MUST ON OR BEFORE YOUR APPEARANCE DATE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING TO THE COURT: NO EXCEPTIONS!!

1. A Plea of Guilty or Nolo (see form below)
2. A Sworn Affidavit (see form below)
3. Proof of Liability Insurance (on the Vehicle driven)
4. The Proper Fee - \$112.00
(Money Order, Cashier Check or Credit Card Only)

If you are eligible and submit the above to the Court on or before your appearance date upon court approval, you will then have ninety (90) days from date of the affidavit to take any State Approved DSC and have your certificate of completion back into the Court. A fine will be owed if you fail to comply timely.

REMIT THIS FORM FOR DRIVERS SAFETY COURSE
