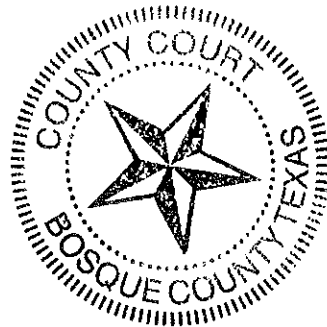

10. Decedent did not apply for and receive Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005.


