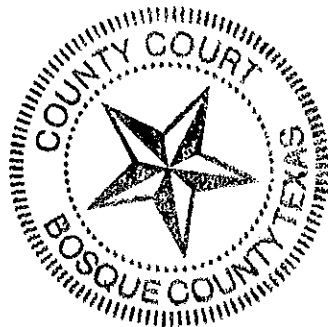



BILLY JAMES SPANABEL ("Applicant") furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of FELICIA SPANABEL ("Decedent") and for issuance of Letters of Administration to Applicant.

1. BILLY JAMES SPANABEL is an individual interested in this estate, domiciled in and residing at 13310 Myrtle Lane, Houston, Texas 77079, the physical address at which service can be had on Applicant. The last three digits of Applicant's social security number are 653. The last three digits of Applicant's drivers license number are 165.

2. Decedent died on August 13, 2020, in Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 93 years, and four years have not elapsed since Decedent's death. The last three digits of Decedent's social security number are 638. The last three digits of Decedent's drivers license number are unknown.

3. Decedent was domiciled in and had a fixed place of residence in this county on the date of death, being 131 CR 1747, Clifton, Texas 76634.

4. Decedent owned real and personal property, generally described as house and lot, furniture and furnishings, automobile and other assets, having a probable value in excess of \$100,000.

5. Decedent left a valid written Will dated February 26, 2018 which was never revoked and the original of which will be filed herewith.


6. The names of the subscribing witnesses to the Will are: Janice S. Harp and Sandra

Smith. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.
8. After the date of the will, no marriage of Decedent was dissolved.
9. A necessity exists for the administration of this estate.
10. The Will named Community Bank and Trust to serve without bond or other security as Independent Executor, but such entity has signed a Waiver and Renunciation of Right to Letters Testamentary which will be filed herewith.
11. Applicant is Decedent's only child, is qualified to be appointed as administrator with will annexed of this estate, and is not disqualified by law to act as such.
12. Neither the state, a governmental agency of the state, nor a charitable organization is named by the will as a devisee.

Applicant prays that citation be issued as required by law to all persons interested in this estate; that Decedent's Will be admitted to probate; that Letters of Administration be issued to Applicant without bond; and that all other orders be made as the Court may deem proper.
