



**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL AND
ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

JANIS LITTLEFIELD ("Applicant") furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of BOBBY JOE LITTLEFIELD ("Decedent"), and for issuance of Letters Testamentary:

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled in and residing at 212 CR 1766, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas. The last three numbers of Applicant's social security number are 850. Applicant's last three numbers of her driver's license are 093.

2. Decedent died on July 25, 2020, domiciled in and residing at 212 CR 1766, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 66 years. The last three numbers of Decedent's social security number were 996. Decedent's last three numbers of his driver's license were 489.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled in and had a fixed place of residence in Bosque County, Texas, on the date of death.

4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as a home, cash, miscellaneous property and household goods and personal effects of a probable value in excess of \$100,000.00.

5. Decedent left a valid written Will ("Will") dated June 14, 2016, which was never revoked and is filed herewith.

6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will and their present resident addresses are BRADLEY M. PETTIET, whose address is 1661 Broadway, Lubbock, Texas 79401, and

CAMERON BOWEN, whose address is 1661 Broadway, Lubbock, Texas 79401. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.

8. Decedent's Will named Applicant, JANIS LITTLEFIELD, to serve without bond or other security as Independent Executor, in which capacity Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters.

9. No marriage of Decedent was ever dissolved after the date of the Will.

10. A necessity exists for the administration of this Estate.

11. Decedent's Will does not name the state, a governmental agency of the state, or a charitable organization as a devisee.

12. Applicant files this Application for Probate of Will and Issuance of Letters Testamentary, in good faith and with just cause, for the purpose of having the Will admitted to probate.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that:

- A. Citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate;
- B. The Will be admitted to probate;
- C. Letters Testamentary be issued to Applicant; and
- D. That all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
