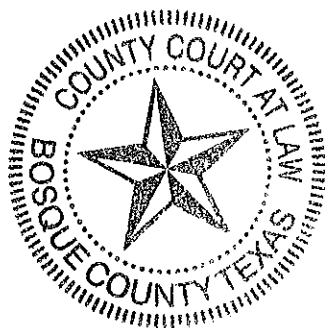

**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL
AND ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

EVERETT L. JEWELL ("Applicant") furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of **SOL D. JEWELL**, ("Decedent"):

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled in and residing at 422 Blueberry Lane, Red Oak, Ellis County, Texas 75154.

2. Decedent died on SEPTEMBER 4, 2020, in Waco, McLennan County, Texas at 78 years of age, but was a resident of and had a place of residence in Bosque County, Texas as the time of her death.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence in this county on the date of death.

4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as home, cash, automobiles, household goods and personal

effects, of a probable value in excess of \$100,000.00.

5. Decedent left a written Will ("Will") dated MARCH 8, 2018, which was never revoked and an executed copy is filed herewith.

6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will are Paulette Meany of Waxahachie, Texas and Rosa Ramirez of Glenn Heights, Texas. The Will is made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.

8. At the time of her death, the Decedent was married to EVERT H. JEWELL. There are no other marriages of the Decedent.

9. There are debts owed by Decedent which are not secured by liens upon real estate and there are assets the holders of which are requiring Letters Testamentary, so there is a necessity for any administration of this Estate.

10. The state, a governmental agency of the state, or charitable organization is not named in said Will as a devisee.

11. Applicant is not in default in failing to present the Will for probate within four years of Decedent's death.

12. Decedent did not apply for or receive any Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005.


13. EVERT H. JEWELL was named as the Executor of Decedent's Last Will and Testament, but has declined to serve. A copy of

the Declination to Serve is filed with this Application. EVERETT L. JEWELL was named as the First Alternate Independent Executor in the Decedent's Last Will and Testament. In accordance with the Texas Estates Code, he requests that he be named as an Independent Executor of the Decedent's Last Will and Testament and that no other action be had in the probate court in relation to the settlement of the Decedent's estate other than the probating and recording of the Decedent's Last Will and Testament and the return of an inventory, appraisement, and list of claims or an affidavit in lieu thereof. Applicant is not disqualified by law from serving as Independent Executor or from accepting Letters Testamentary and is entitled to such letters.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to EVERETT L. JEWELL; that no Compliance Affidavit under Section 257.103 of the Texas Estates Code be required; and that all other Orders be entered as the Court may deem appropriate.
