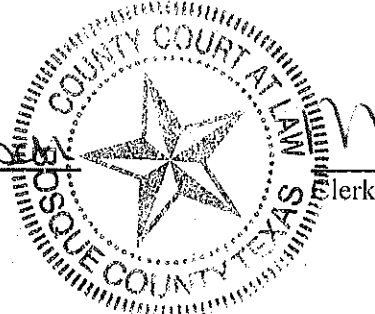
All persons interested in said cause are hereby cited to appear before said Honorable Court at said above mentioned time and place by filing a written answer contesting said request if they so desire.

The clerk may require a deposit to cover the estimated costs of furnishing you with the request notice.



AMENDED APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF
PERMANENT GUARDIAN OF THE PERSON AND ESTATE

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

NOW COMES, Ashley Bradshaw, ("Applicant"), and makes and files this Application for Appointment of Guardian of the Person and Estate of John Clayton Pugh, an Adult, ("Proposed Ward") pursuant to Section 1101.001 of the Texas Estates Code, and would respectfully show the Court the following:

I.

That alternatives to guardianship, including available supports and services that would avoid the need for a guardianship, were not considered feasible.

II.

That Proposed Ward is a male who is 18 old, having been born on April 12, 2002. The Proposed Ward's currently resides at 3718 FM 217, Valley Mills, Bosque County, Texas. The last three digits of the social security number of the Proposed Ward are 638. The Proposed Ward is not currently under a guardianship. John Clayton Pugh is currently in the care and custody of Ashley Bradshaw, 3718 FM 217, Valley Mills, Texas.

No one holds a power of attorney signed by the Proposed Ward.

III.

The names, addresses, and relationships to the Proposed Ward of those relatives required to be listed in this Application by Section 1101.001(13) of the Texas Estates Code, to the best of the Applicant's knowledge are as follows:

IV.

Applicant is the mother of the Proposed Ward and her address is 3718 FM 217, Valley Mills, Bosque County, Texas. The last three digits of the social security number of the Applicant are 360. Applicant desires to be appointed Guardian of the Person and Estate of Proposed Ward, which Estate is valued at \$200, including any compensation, pension, insurance, or allowance to which the Proposed Ward may be entitled. The Estate of the Proposed Ward generally consists of the following types of property: personal affects. Applicant's interest in the appointment of a guardian is as a relative of the Proposed Ward, as previously indicated, she is eligible by law to act as Guardian.

The father of the Proposed Ward has consented to Ashley Bradshaw being appointed as legal guardian of the Proposed Ward as evidenced by a Consent/Waiver of Parent duly filed with this Court.

V.

This Court has venue over these proceedings because the principal share of John Clayton Pugh's Estate is located in this county.

VI.

Proposed Ward is an adult, and is incapacitated because of a mental condition. Proposed Ward is totally without capacity, as provided by the Texas Estates Code, to care for himself, to manage his property, to operate a motor vehicle, to vote in a public election, and make personal decisions regarding residence.

VII.

Applicant requests the Court appoint her as Guardian of the Person and Estate of John Clayton Pugh, to see to the care of all of Proposed Ward's personal and physical needs and manage all of Proposed Ward's financial affairs and the assets of his Estate.

VIII


Applicant states to the Court that the following facts and reasons support the request for appointment of a Guardian and the granting of the requested powers: Proposed Ward is developmentally challenged and is unable to care for himself and manage his affairs. Applicant request any and all powers relating to the care of Proposed Ward, both of the person and estate.

Applicant prays that a hearing on this Application be set; that Applicant, Ashley Bradshaw, be appointed Guardian of the Person and Estate of John Clayton Pugh, an Adult; that the Court Order appointing Ashley Bradshaw as Guardian be effective upon her taking the Oath and giving a bond as required by law; that upon the Guardian's qualification, the Clerk of this Court shall issue Letters of Guardianship to Ashley Bradshaw; that the Court appoint an attorney and/or guardian ad litem, if they have not already been appointed, to represent the Ward's Person and Estate; and that the Court enter any other Orders it deems necessary.



5. THE RIGHT TO A CLOSED HEARING, IF REQUESTED BY RESPONDENT OR HIS ATTORNEY

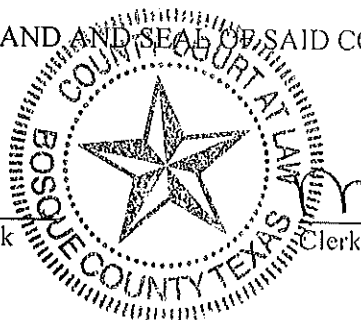
You do have the right to hire your own attorney if you so desire. At said above mentioned time and place, you and all other persons interested may contest said Application if you so desire.
