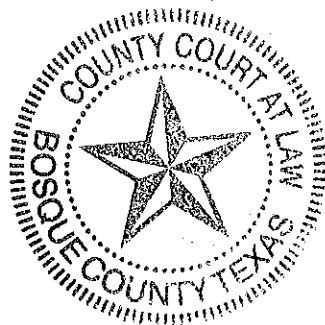

**APPLICATION TO PROBATE WILL AND CODICIL AND
FOR ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Virginia Dell Sampson ("Applicant"), furnishes the following information to the Court in support of this Application for the probate of the Will and Codicil of John Ezra Sampson ("Decedent"), and for issuance of Letters Testamentary:

1. Applicant, Virginia Dell Sampson, is an individual interested in this Estate, being domiciled in and residing in Texas. Virginia Dell Sampson's address for service of citation is P.O. Box 723, Stanton, Texas 79782. The last three digits of the social security number of Virginia Dell Sampson are 346. The last three digits of the driver's license number of Virginia Dell Sampson are 766.

2. Decedent died on November 18, 2020, at Morgan, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 80 years. Decedent's domicile at the time of his death was Morgan, Bosque County, Texas. The last three digits of the social security number of Decedent are 347.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue is proper because Decedent was domiciled in Texas and had a fixed place of residence in this County on the date of his death.

4. Decedent owned property described generally as real estate, cash, personal effects and household goods of a probable value in excess of \$50,000.

5. Decedent left a valid Will dated April 4, 1995, and one Codicil dated October 3, 2006, which were never revoked. A true and correct copy of the Will and the Codicil are attached. The Will and the Codicil will be delivered to the County Clerk pursuant to the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.

6. A necessity exists for the administration of the Estate.

7. After the date of the Codicil, no child was born to or adopted by Decedent.

8. No marriage of the Decedent was ever dissolved after the will was made.

9. Decedent's First Codicil of the Last Will and Testament named Virginia Dell Sampson to serve as Independent Executrix to act independently. Virginia Dell Sampson resides in Stanton, Martin County, Texas. Virginia Dell Sampson is not disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and is entitled to such letters.


10. No state, governmental agency of the state, nor charitable organization is named by the Will as a devisee.

11. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law and the subscribing witnesses to the Will are Letha J. Heath, and Francis Bevien.

12. The Codicil dated October 3, 2006 was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law and the subscribing witnesses to the Codicil are Rhonda Hughes and Ellen Shields.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will and Codicil be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to Virginia Dell Sampson; and that all other Orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
