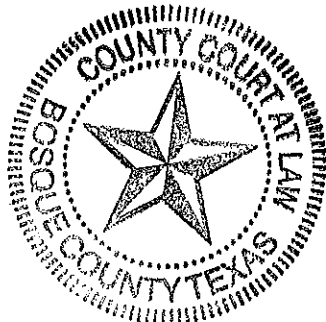

**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Curtis McLemore, Applicant, Social Security number xxx-xx-x206, Driver's License number xxxxx339, furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of William Lee McLemore, Social Security number xxx-xx-x562, Driver's License number xxxxx791, as a Muniment of Title:

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled in and residing at 2611 Spring Valley Road, Lorena, McLennan County, Texas.
2. Decedent died on April 3, 2015 in Clifton, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 87 years.
3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence in this county at the time of Decedent's death.
4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as home, cash, household goods, personal effects, of a probable value in excess of \$100,000.
5. Decedent left a valid written will dated October 6, 1993, which was never revoked and is filed herewith.
6. The Will was made self proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. No child or children were born to or adopted by the Decedent after the date of the Will.

8. After the date of Decedent's will, no marriage of Decedent was dissolved.

9. There are no debts owed by Decedent which are not secured by liens upon real estate and there is no necessity for any administration of this Estate.

10. There are no gifts to charitable organizations or governmental agencies contained in the Will of the Decedent.

11. Excusable neglect exists for not presenting the Will for probate within four years of Decedent's death. The Will of Decedent was discovered and located during Applicant's function as Temporary Administrator of the Estate of Beverly McLemore in Cause No. P08403 filed in the County Court at Law of Bosque County, Texas. Beverly McLemore was the surviving spouse of Decedent William Lee McLemore.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this estate; that the Will be admitted to probate as a Muniment of Title and without any administration thereon; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
