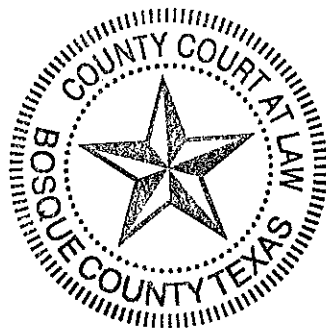

APPLICATION TO DECLARE HEIRSHIP
AND
FOR LETTERS OF INDEPENDENT ADMINISTRATION

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The undersigned Applicant, CLARENCE ORAN BRIGHT files this Application for Administration of the property and Estate of LYVONNE MARIE JACKSON, Decedent, and for Letters of Independent Administration and to Determine Heirship:

1. To Applicant’s best knowledge and belief, LYVONNE MARIE JACKSON, “Decedent”, died without a Will.
2. Applicant, CLARENCE ORAN BRIGHT is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled in and residing at 3675 South U.S. Highway 281, Hamilton, Hamilton County, Texas 76531. The last three digits of the Social Security number of CLARENCE BRIGHT are XXX-XX-X684. Applicant is the brother of the Decedent and Applicant is entitled to first priority under Section 304.001 of the Texas Estates Code along with Applicant’s sister.
3. Applicant expects that Applicants living siblings who are LENNIE MAYE GILLENLINE and RAY ALDON BRIGHT will consent to the appointment of Applicant as sole Independent Administrator of the Decedent’s estate without bond.
4. Decedent died on July 5, 2020 in Iredell, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 86 years.
5. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence at 143 W. Sweden Street, Walnut Springs, Bosque County, Texas 76690 on the date of her death.
6. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as real estate of a probable value of \$10,000.00.

7. A necessity exists to determine Heirship of the Decedent and for the administration of Decedent's property and Estate to consider payment of claims, and to resolve other matters which require the authorization of a personal representative in settling Decedent's estate.
8. Applicant is qualified and not disqualified by law from serving as Sole Administrator of Decedent's Estate.
9. Applicant requests that this Court, upon notice and hearing as required by law, appoint CLARENCE ORAN BRIGHT as Independent Administrator, without bond or with bond (if required by the Court), and for such other and further orders appropriate to this Estate.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons in this Estate; and to all unknown heirs, if any, that Letters granting Independent Administration (with or without bond as the court may determine) be issued solely to Applicant; that the Court declare Applicant and Decedent's siblings (named above) to be the heirs of the Decedent; and that all other Orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
