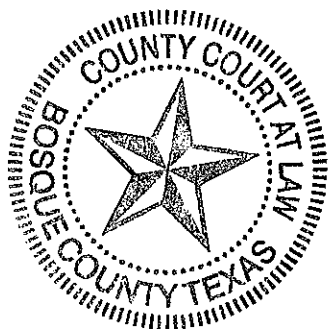

APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL
AS MUNIMENT OF TITLE

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Shannon Ray Dollins ("Applicant"), furnishes the following information to the Court in support of this application for the probate of the Will of Beatrice Louise Powers ("Decedent") as a Muniment of Title:

1. Shannon Ray Dollins, Applicant, is an individual interested in this Estate, and is domiciled in and residing in 106 W Avenue E, Valley Mills,. Shannon Ray Dollins's address for service of citation is 106 W Avenue E, Valley Mills. The last three digits of the driver's license number of Shannon Ray Dollins are 399. The last three digits of the social security number are 194.
2. Decedent died on January 19, 2018 at Clifton, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 99 years. Decedent's domicile at the time of her death was 106 W Avenue E, Valley Mills, Tx 76689. The last three digits of the driver's license number of Decedent are 621.
3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled in Texas and had a fixed place of residence in this County on the date of her death.
4. At the time of Decedent's death, Decedent owned real property in the State of Texas and personal property, generally described as real estate, cash, personal effects and household goods, with a probable value in excess of \$75,000.00.

5. Decedent did apply for and receive Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005. However, a hardship waiver has been granted in full. A copy of the letter from The Texas Medicaid Estate Recovery Contractor granting such hardship waiver is attached hereto.

6. Decedent left a valid Will dated January 6, 2014, which was never revoked and is filed herewith.

7. The Will was not self-proved in the manner prescribed by law, but the Will was executed with the formalities and solemnities and under the circumstances required by law to make it a valid Will. At the time Decedent executed the Will, Decedent had attained the age of eighteen (18) years and was of sound mind.

8. The subscribing witnesses to the Will are as follows:

Witness: Jason Scott Healy

Witness: Amy Dawson Ruhman now known as Amy Dawson Healy

Witness: Vicki Foster

9. The Will named Shannon Ray Dollins as Executor, whose residence address is 106 N Avenue E, Valley Mills, Tx 76689.

10. No children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.


11. No marriage of the Decedent was ever dissolved after the Will was made.

12. Neither the state, a governmental agency of the state, nor a charitable organization is named by the Will as a devisee.

13. Applicant has investigated the affairs of the Decedent and finds that to the best of Applicant's knowledge and belief, there are no unpaid debts owing by the Estate of the Decedent, exclusive of any debt secured by liens on real estate, and there is no necessity for administration on such Estate.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate as a Muniment of Title only; that the requirement for the filing of an Affidavit of Fulfillment of Terms of Will be waived; and that all other Orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
