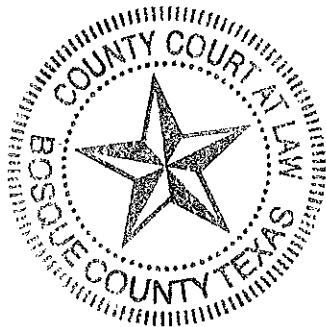

**APPLICATION TO PROBATE WILL AND  
FOR ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

**TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:**

Michael R. Alexander ("Applicant"), furnishes the following information to the Court in support of this Application for the probate of the Will of Betty J. Alexander ("Decedent"), and for issuance of Letters Testamentary:

1. Applicant, Michael R. Alexander, is an individual interested in this Estate, being domiciled in and residing at 912 Brice, Meridian, Bosque County, Texas 76665. Michael R. Alexander's address for service of citation is 912 Brice, Meridian, Bosque County, Texas 76665. The last three digits of the social security number of Michael R. Alexander are 306. The last three digits of the driver's license number of Michael R. Alexander are 241.

2. Decedent died on October 15, 2021, at Goodall-Witcher Hospital in Clifton, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 91 years. Decedent's domicile at the time of her death was Clifton, Bosque County, Texas. The last three digits of the driver's license number of Decedent are 760. The last three digits of the social security number of Decedent are 448.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue is proper because Decedent was domiciled in Texas and had a fixed place of residence in this County on the date of her death.

4. Decedent owned property described generally as cash, personal effects and household goods of a probable value in excess of \$625,000.00.

5. Decedent left a valid Will dated September 20, 1975, which was never revoked.

6. The Will will be delivered to the County Clerk pursuant to the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.

7. A necessity exists for the administration of the Estate.

8. After the date of the Will, no child was born to or adopted by Decedent.

9. No marriage of the Decedent was ever dissolved after the will was made.


10. Decedent's Will named Summers R. Alexander to serve as Independent Executor to act independently. However, Summers R. Alexander predeceased Decedent on August 8, 2002. Decedent's Will named Michael R. Alexander to serve as Independent Executor to act independently in the event Summers R. Alexander is not living or does not act. Michael R. Alexander resides at 912 Brice, Meridian, Bosque County, Texas. Michael R. Alexander is not disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and is entitled to such letters.

11. No state, governmental agency of the state, nor charitable organization is named by the Will as a devisee.

12. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law and the subscribing witnesses to the Will are Charles R. Briley, and W. P. Weatherford.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to Michael R. Alexander; and that all other Orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
