

Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The Bosque County conducted public hearings on September 12, 2011 and September 19, 2011 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Bosque County from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 9.03 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.4150 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$3,840,768.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.4056 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$4,171,538.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.4056 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$4,228,818.

The County of Bosque County is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 26, 2011 at Bosque County Commissioners Courtroom, 110 South Main St., Meridian, TX 76665 at 9:30 am.
