

Bosque County, in accordance with federal and state law, has redistricted the commissioners court boundaries and will be promptly securing preclearance from the United States Department of Justice under Section 5 of the Federal Voting Rights Act. The Texas Election Code § 42.035 also requires that beginning in the first week following the week in which an order changing a county election precinct boundary is adopted, the commissioners court shall publish notice of the change in the newspaper of the county once a week for three consecutive weeks. In accordance with the code requirement, the changes made to Bosque County are as follows:

Very small change in Clifton and Laguna Park to insure the principle of “one-person -one-vote” that all districts have essentially the same number of people and do not have a discriminatory purpose or effect upon the rights of minorities to vote.
