

Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The Bosque County Commissioner's Court conducted public hearings on September 8, 2009 and September 14, 2009 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues for Bosque County from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 9.94 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.3586 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$3,442,698.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.3717 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$3,721,526.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.3717 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$3,800,660.

The Commissioner's Court of Bosque County is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 28, 2009 at Bosque County Commissioner's Courtroom - Meridian, Texas 76665 at 9:00 am.
