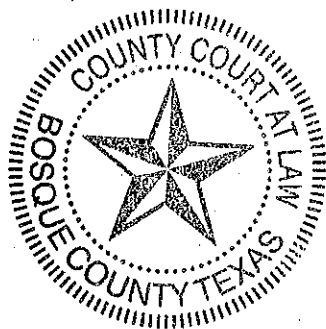


All persons interested in said estate are hereby cited to appear before said Honorable Court at said above mentioned time and place by filing a written answer contesting such application should they desire to do so.

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

RONALD E. HARMOND ("Applicant") furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of MARY JANE MCLAREN HARMOND, ("Decedent") and for issuance of Letters Testamentary to Applicant:


1. Applicant, RONALD E. HARMOND is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled and residing at 514 S. Broadway Street, Meridian, Texas 76665. The last three digits of, RONALD E. HARMOND's social security number are xxx-xx-x196.
2. Decedent died on May 26, 2022 in Waco, McLennan County, Texas, at the age of 75 years. The last three digits of Decedent's social security number are xxx-xx-x132.
3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence at, 514 S. Broadway Street, Meridian, Texas 76665 on the date of Decedent's death.
4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as a home, a vehicle, household goods, and personal effects, of a probable value in excess of \$200,000.00.
5. Decedent left a valid written Will ("Will") dated May 9, 2013 which was never revoked and is filed herewith.
6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will are Natalie Koehler whose present address is P.O. Box 215, Meridian, Texas 76665 and Aubrey Morgan whose present address is unknown and the Will is self proved.

7. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.
8. Decedent was married once and one time only to Ronald E. Harmond and three (3) children were born to that marriage. No other children were born to or adopted by Decedent.
9. No marriage of the Decedent was dissolved after the date of the Will (See Section 256.052 Estates Code) except by the death of the Decedent.
10. A necessity exists for the administration of this estate.
11. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve as Independent Executor without bond or other security and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters.
12. Decedent's Will did not name either the State of Texas, a governmental agency of the State of Texas, or a charitable organization as a devisee.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to Applicant as Independent Executor without bond; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
