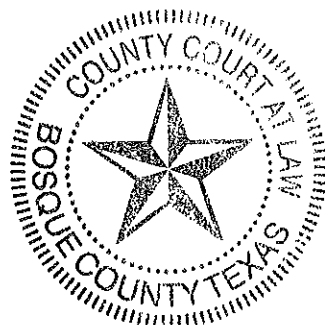

All persons interested in said estate are hereby cited to appear before said Honorable Court at said above mentioned time and place by filing a written answer contesting such application should they desire to do so.





**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

CHARLES JACOB NIXON ("Applicant") furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of BRENDA CHRIS GOODWIN ("Decedent") and for issuance of Letters Testamentary to Applicant:


1. Applicant, CHARLES JACOB NIXON, is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled in and residing at 7546 New Glendale Rd., Glendale, KY 42740. The last three digits of Applicant's social security number are 137. The last three digits of Decedent's social security number are 170.
2. Decedent died on August 26, 2022 in Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 60 years.
3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence at 161 CR 3135, Valley Mills, Texas, 76689 on the date of her death.
4. Decedent owned real and personal property described as cash, house, household goods, personal effects and stock, of a probable value in excess of \$50,000.00.
5. Decedent left a valid written Will ("Will") dated November 2, 2020 which was never revoked and is filed herewith.
6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will and their last known addresses are KENT BRATCHER, 113 W. River St., Meridian, Texas 76665 and BILLY H. VANNATTA, 1000 Briar Drive, Waco, Texas 76710. The Will is made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.
7. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.

8. A necessity exists for the administration of this estate.
9. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve as Independent Executor without bond or other security and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters.
10. Decedent's Will did not name either the State of Texas, a governmental agency of the State of Texas, or a charitable organization as a devisee.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to Applicant; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
