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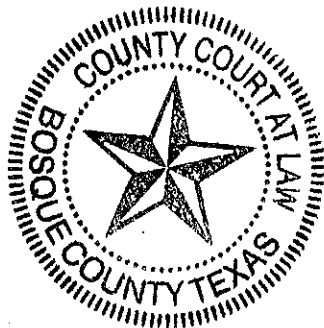

**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF A WILL**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Applicant applies for the probate of the will of Lanelle Waddill Taylor, deceased (the "decedent"), and for the issuance of letters testamentary, and shows the court the following:

1.

Applicant is Peter L. Taylor, is domiciled at 9128 Tawny Lynx Road, Loveland, Colorado 80538. The last three digits of the social security number of Applicant are 665. The last three digits of the Colorado driver's license number of Applicant are 674. It is anticipated that Applicant will appoint his attorney, Cara M. Chase, as resident agent for service of process in this proceeding.

2.

Decedent died on October 4, 2022, in Waco, McLennan County, Texas, at the age of 87 years. At the time of her death, Decedent resided at the College Hill Assisted Living facility, located at 1700 West 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas. The last three digits of the social security number of Decedent were 893 and the last three digits of Decedent's driver's license were 113.

3.

This Court has jurisdiction and venue is proper because Decedent was domiciled in Texas and had a fixed place of residence in this County on the date of her death.

4.

At the time of death, the decedent owned property of a probable value in excess of \$15,000.00, consisting of a vehicle, bank accounts, real property and personal effects.

5.

The decedent left a written will dated August 24, 1998, which was never revoked, a copy of which is filed herewith. Such will was self-proved in accordance with Section 251.101 of the Texas Estates Code and the subscribing witnesses to the will were Lawrence L. Garcia and Sohui Chong.

6.

No child was born to or adopted by the decedent subsequent to the making of such will.

7.

After the will was made, a marriage of the decedent was dissolved by the death of decedent's spouse, Norman Wheeler Taylor, on February 1, 2011.

8.

Neither the state, a governmental agency of the state nor a charitable organization is named as a devisee in the will.

9.

The Will named Jonathan W. Taylor as primary Independent Executor. It is anticipated that Jonathan W. Taylor will file with the Court a Waiver and Renunciation of his right to serve in such capacity in favor of Applicant.

10.

No necessity exists for the appointment of appraisers.

11.

A necessity exists for an administration of the Decedent's estate.

12.

Applicant has made a diligent search for the signed original Will and has been unable to locate it, but believes that the Decedent did not revoke the Will prior to her death. The contents of the original Will are identical to those set forth in the copy of such Will filed herewith. Since the signed original Will cannot by any reasonable diligence be produced, Applicant requests that, pursuant to Section 256.054 of the Texas Estates Code, the Will be probated as a written will not produced in Court and that the Court, pursuant to Section 256.156 of the Texas Estates Code, declare that the contents of such Will are identical to the attached copy.

13.
