

BOSQUE COUNTY ORDINANCE #2

CRIMINAL PENALTY

(a) A person commits an offense if:

- (1) the person violates Bosque County Ordinance #1;
- (2) the nuisance remains unabated after the 30th day after the date on which the person receives notice from a county official, agent, or employee to abate the nuisance.

(b) An offense under this section is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$50 or more than \$200.

(c) If it is shown on the trial of the defendant that the defendant has been previously convicted of an offense under this section, the defendant is punishable by a fine of not less than \$200 or more than \$1,000, confinement in jail for not more than six months, or both.

(d) Each day a violation occurs is a separate offense.

(e) The court shall order abatement of the nuisance if the defendant is convicted of an offense under this section.

Commissioner Worley made the motion to approve the minutes from the April 12, 2004 meeting. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. All approved.

SALARIES AND WAGES AGAINST COUNTY FUNDS**

Commissioner Worley made the motion to approve to pay claims, salaries and wages of \$31,752.80. Commissioner Koonsman seconded the motion. All approved.

7) ORDER APPROVING OR DISAPPROVING TO PAY CLAIMS, SALARIES AND WAGES AGAINST PRECINCT FUNDS

Commissioner Smith made the motion to approve to pay claims, salaries and wages against Precinct funds. Commissioner Koonsman seconded the motion. All approved.

8) LINE ITEM TRANSFERS

Commissioner Koonsman made the motion to approve the line item transfers. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion. All approved.

9) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON ADOPTING GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR BOSQUE COUNTY TAX ABATEMENT

Commissioner Worley made the motion to approve the guidelines and criteria for Bosque County Tax Abatement. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. All approved.

10) EXECUTIVE SESSION WILL BE HELD FOR PURPOSES PERMITTED BY GOVERNMENT CODE; ART. 551.071 CONSULT WITH ATTORNEY REGARDING TAX DELINQUENCY

Judge Word, the four Commissioners, Jane Murphey, Auditor, and Robert Meyer, Tax Attorney went into executive session at 9:12 AM and returned to the regular session at 9:55 AM.

11) DISCUSSION AND ACTION PURSUANT TO EXECUTIVE SESSION: CONSIDER SETTling OF TAX CLAIM AND GRANTING A TAX ABATEMENT FOR MIRANT

Commissioner Smith made the motion to authorize the county judge to negotiate and approve a settlement in payment of taxes and granting a tax abatement with Mirant Corporation. Commissioner Guinn seconded the motion. All approved.

12) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON ADOPTING PROCEDURES AND ORDINANCES FOR LITTER ABATEMENT

Commissioner Koonsman made the motion to adopt procedures and ordinances for litter abatement. This action is necessary for the litter abatement officer to be able to ticket offenders (Class C Misdemeanor). Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. All approved.

13) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON APPROVAL OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BOSQUE COUNTY AND CITY OF MERIDIAN

Commissioner Smith made the motion to accept the interlocal agreement between Bosque County and City of Meridian that has been approved by the County Attorney. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion. All approved.

14) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON ADVERTISING FOR MOBILE COMMAND AND COMMUNICATIONS UNIT FOR THE COUNTY OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Commissioner Worley made the motion to approve advertising for bids for the mobile command and communications unit for the county office of emergency management. Commissioner Guinn seconded the motion. All approved.

15) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON PURCHASING NEW REPEATER FOR BOSQUE COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT

Commissioner Smith made the motion to approve the purchase of a new repeater for Bosque County Law Enforcement. Approval for the Homeland Security Grant that will reimburse the county will be given before the order is placed with Comtex Communications. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion. All approved.

16) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON REGARDING WHITNEY WATER DEPARTMENT AND ADOPTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

No action taken – pending a conference with the County Attorney.

17) DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING SPEED BUMP ON COUNTY ROAD 1409

18) DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING TRADE-IN OF PICKUPS

Commissioner Smith made the motion to approve the addition of this line to the bids for trucks: "and/or Trade-In". Commissioner Guinn seconded the motion. All approved.

19) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON RESOLUTION REGARDING LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROCURING A TRUCK

Commissioner Koonsman made the motion to pass and sign the resolution regarding the lease purchase agreement for the purpose of procuring a truck for his precinct. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. All approved.

20) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON SALE OF EIGHT-LINER GAMING MACHINES

Commissioner Smith made the motion to approve the sale of the confiscated eight-liner gaming machines that have been cleared for sale through district court in lots of 100 or more. The machines will be put out for sale in the same manner as other surplus property and the sale price will go into the county general fund. Commissioner Koonsman seconded the motion. All approved.

21) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON PURCHASE OF PRINTER FOR TAX OFFICE

Commissioner Smith made the motion to approve the purchase of a printer for the Tax Office from The Software Group. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion. All approved.

Bids were opened from The Railroad Yard, Inc. (no bid) and Wilson Culverts, Inc. at 10:15 a.m. Commissioner Smith made the motion to award the bid for culverts to Wilson Culverts, Inc. Commissioner Koonsman seconded the motion. All approved.

24) DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON OPENING/REJECTING/AWARDING BIDS FOR COLD MIX: 9:35 A.M.

Bids were opened from Vulcan Materials at 10:20 a.m. Commissioner Koonsman made the motion to award the bid to Vulcan Materials. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. All approved.

the motion to award the bid to Cleveland Asphalt Products, Inc. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion. All approved.
