A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF BOSQUE COUNTY, TEXAS ADOPTING THE FEMA APPROVED BOSQUE COUNTY MULTI JURISIDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION ACTION PLAN (HAZMAP) DATED DECEMBER 28, 2015.

WHEREAS, the Bosque County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Bosque County, Texas; and
