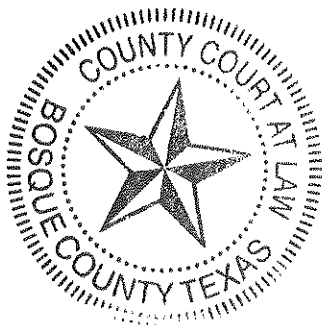


All persons interested in said estate are hereby cited to appear before said Honorable Court at said above mentioned time and place by filing a written answer contesting such application should they desire to do so.

**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL  
 AND ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

To the Honorable Judge of the Court:

**Timothy Miller**, *Applicant*, furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of **Julie V. Hinote**, *Decedent*, and for issuance of *Letters Testamentary*:

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this estate, domiciled in and residing at 253 CR 3340, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634. The last three digits of Applicant's Social Security and Texas driver's license numbers are 565 and 219, respectively.

2. Decedent died on November 30, 2022, at Kingwood Medical Center, Houston, Montgomery County, Texas 77339, at the age of 37 years. The last three digits of Decedent's Social Security number and driver's license numbers are 029 and 070, respectively.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent resided in this county at the time of death and Decedent owned property interests in this county.

4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as homestead and other real estate in Bosque County, Texas, bank accounts, a vehicle, household goods and personal effects of a probable value of less than \$500,000.

5. Decedent left a valid, written Will dated October 19, 2022, *the Will*, which was never revoked and is filed in this cause.

6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will were Patricia Ferguson, who currently resides near China Spring, Bosque County, Texas & Libby Robertson, who currently resides near Clifton, Bosque County, Texas. The Will was self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. Decedent was married twice. Her first marriage was to Curtis Rust, which ended in divorce in about the year 2007 in Bosque County, Texas. No children were born of this marriage.

Decedent's second and final marriage was to Michael E. Hinote in the year 2009, which ended in her death. Of this marriage, only four children were born:

**Lukas Miller Hinote**, a minor, residing at 253 CR 3340, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634;

**Ella Vere Hinote**, a minor, residing at 253 CR 3340, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634;

**Tessa Aileen Hinote**, a minor, residing at 253 CR 3340, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634; and

**Jakob Michael Hinote**, a stillborn infant who died June 29, 2012.

No other child was ever born to Decedent, adopted by Decedent, or taken into Decedent's home with the understanding of adoption.

None of Decedent's marriages were dissolved after the date of the Will.

8. A necessity exists for administration of this estate.

9. Neither Texas, nor any governmental agency of Texas, nor any charitable organization is named in the Will as a devisee. Michael E. Hinote, the primary residuary beneficiary, who died January 26, 2023 and failed to survive Decedent by 180 days, as required by Section 9.5. Therefore, his gift lapsed and passes equally to Lukas Miller Hinote, Ella Vere Hinote and Tessa Aileen Hinote, IN TRUST. The Will's beneficiaries are Lukas Miller Hinote, residing at 253 CR 3340, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634; Ella

Vere Hinote, residing at 253 CR 3340, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634; and Tessa Aileen Hinote, residing at 253 CR 3340, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634.

10. Decedent did not apply for or receive Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005.


11. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve without bond or other security as Independent Executor, and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting *Letters Testamentary*, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters. The Will's first-named Executor, Michael E. Hinote, died on January 26, 2023 in Clifton, Bosque County, Texas.

12. Decedent's Will (paragraph 7) grants the Independent Executor full power and authority over Decedent's assets, including the power to sell, manage and dispose of Decedent's property.

13. Pursuant to *Texas Estates Code Section 256.052(b)*, no information required for this Application has been omitted.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that *Letters Testamentary* be issued to Applicant; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
