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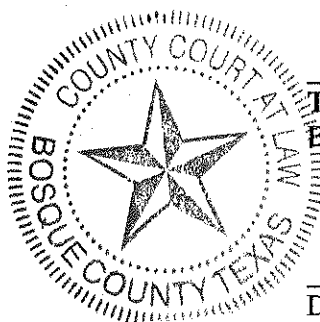



APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL AS A MUNIMENT OF TITLE  
AND WAIVER OF THE REQUIREMENT TO FILE AN AFFIDAVIT  
PURSUANT TO TEXAS ESTATES CODE SECTION 257.103

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

JAMES A. CAMPBELL ("Applicant") furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of ELSIE M. JOHNSON ("Decedent") as a Muniment of Title:

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled in and residing at 252 County Road 1630, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas.
2. The last three digits of the Applicant's social security number are 544; the last three digits of the Applicant's driver's license number are 916.
3. Decedent died on October 18, 2022, in Clifton, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of ninety-nine (99) years.
4. The last three digits of the Decedent's social security number are 650; the last three digits of the Decedent's driver's license number are 089.
5. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence in this county on the date of death.
6. Decedent owned real and personal property of a probable value in excess of \$50,000.00.
7. Decedent left a valid written Will ("Will") dated October 13, 2016, which was never revoked and is filed herewith. The subscribing witnesses to the Will are Antonio E. Caufield and Julie A. Dixon. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.
8. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.
9. No state, governmental agency, or charitable organization is named as a beneficiary in the Will of Decedent.

10. No marriage of the Decedent was ever dissolved after the Will was made.
11. There are no debts owed by the Decedent which are not secured by liens upon real estate and there is no necessity for any administration of this Estate.
12. Decedent did not apply for and receive Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005.
13. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve without bond or other security as Independent Executor.
14. Applicant requests that the requirement for the filing of an Affidavit pursuant to Texas Estates Code Section 257.103 be waived.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this estate; that the Will be admitted to probate as a Muniment of Title and without any administration thereon; that the requirement of the filing of an Affidavit be waived; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
