Application for Probate of Will
and Issuance of Letters Testamentary

1. William H. Watson ("Applicant") files this application pursuant to Estates Code § 256.051 and 301.051 for probate of will and issuance of letters testamentary concerning the estate of Eva Sue Watson ("Decedent").

2. Applicant's domicile, resident, and mailing address is 4517 FM 1991, Meridian, Texas 76665, last three driver's license numbers are 439, and last three social security numbers are 691.

3. Decedent died testate on August 8, 2023, at the age of eighty-two, in Bosque County, Texas, residing and domiciled at 4517 FM 1991, Meridian, Texas 76665.

4. Decedent's last three driver's license numbers are 063 and last three social security numbers are 251.

5. Applicant is Decedent's surviving spouse and executor named in Decedent's will and, as such, an interested person authorized to commence and maintain this proceeding.

6. This Court has venue, because Decedent's domicile and fixed place of residence at death was in Bosque County, Texas.

7. All property belonging to Decedent's estate has a probable value at death of less than \$4,000,000.00 and is generally described as real property, securities, livestock, farm equipment,

tools, furniture, furnishings, appliances, household goods, clothing, and personal effects.

8. Decedent's last and unrevoked will (the "Will") is written, dated August 7, 2022, and witnessed by Heriberta Herrera and Janice Anderson and will be filed with this application.

9. No child was born to or adopted by Decedent after the Will's execution.

10. No marriage of Decedent was dissolved after the Will was made, whether by divorce, annulment, or declaration of being void.

11. Neither Texas, a governmental agency of Texas, nor a charitable organization is named in the Will as a devisee.

12. An administration of Decedent's estate is needed; so that, (a) its assets can be identified, collected, and protected, (b) claims owed and expenses incurred by it can be identified, classified, and paid to the extent possible, and (c) its remaining assets can be distributed as required by the Will.

13. Applicant is both named in the Will and desires to serve without bond or other security as independent executor of Decedent's estate, is by law both entitled to accept and not disqualified from accepting Letters Testamentary, and can receive service at 4517 FM 1991, Meridian, Texas 76665.

14. Applicant prays:

a. that citation and other notices be had as required by law;

- b. that the Will be admitted to probate;
- c. that Applicant be appointed and issued Letters Testamentary as independent executor of Decedent's estate;
- d. that the Court make all other orders determined necessary or appropriate; and
- e. that Applicant receive all additional legal and equitable relief which Applicant may be entitled to receive.
