APPLICATION TO DETERMINE HEIRSHIP AND APPLICATION FOR INDEPENDENT ADMINISTRATION

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The undersigned Applicant files this <u>Application to Determine Heirship and Application for Independent Administration</u> of the property and Estate of REGINA GAIL NECESSARY, Deceased, and for Letters of Independent Administration:

- 1. To Applicant's best knowledge and belief, REGINA GAIL NECESSARY, Applicant's friend, "Decedent", died without a Will.
- 2. Applicant, BRENDA SNIDER, is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled in and residing at 6799 FM 219, Clifton, Texas 76634. The last three (3) digits of the Social Security number of BRENDA SNIDER are XXX-XX-X026.
- 3. Decedent died on June 9, 2022, in Clifton, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 59 years. The last three (3) digits of the Social Security number of REGINA GAIL NECESSARY are XXX-XX-X632.
- 4. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence at 774 CR 3510, Valley Mills, Bosque County, Texas, 76689 on the date of her death.
- 5. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as real estate, cash, and personal effects, of a probable value in excess of \$75,000.00.
- 6. The Decedent was married one time and one time only to RUSSELL NECESSARY which marriage ended in divorce. To this marriage were born three (3) children who are AMANDA NECESSARY, ALLISON NECESSARY and ANDREA NECESSARY GORE who survived the Decedent. Their fourth child died as an infant.
- 7. Applicant expects that when this Application is heard by the Court that the Court will find that the Decedent had three children who survived the Decedent who are

Amanda Necessary, Allison Necessary and Andrea Necessary Gore (hereinafter referred to as "Amanda, Allison and Andrea").

Applicant would further show unto the Court that the aforementioned three children of the Decedent entered into a <u>Mediated Settlement Agreement</u> dated November 14, 2022 wherein the three aforementioned heirs of the Decedent agreed to the appointment of Applicant as Independent Administrator without bond of the Decedent's estate with additional powers and fees as provided in Exhibit "A" section 3c.

Furthermore the aforementioned heirs of the Decedent agreed that the Decedent's real property would be sold (see Exhibit "A" section 3h).

It appears from the settlement agreement that Andrea Necessary Gore and Allison Necessary were represented by Patricia Ferguson at the mediation and Jacob G. Straub represented Amanda Necessary. - 10. Applicant requests that this Court, upon notice and hearing as required by law, appoint Applicant as Independent Administrator, without bond, and for an Order authorizing her to sell property of the Estate (as agreed) without further Order of the Court.

Applicant also requests that no other action shall be had in this Court other than the return of an Inventory, Appraisement, and List of Claims required by law or affidavit in Lieu thereof as allowed by law and the notice to beneficiaries required by the <u>Texas Estates Code</u> including Section 308.002 and for such other and further orders appropriate to this Estate.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons in this Estate including citation upon unknown heirs; that Letters granting Independent Administration without bond be issued to Applicant; that the Court declare AMANDA NECESSARY, ALLISON NECESSARY and ANDREA NECESSARY GORE as the only heirs of the Decedent; and that all other Orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
