
All persons interested in said estate are hereby cited to appear before said Honorable Court at said above mentioned time and place by filing a written answer contesting such application should they desire to do so.



**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL  
AND ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

To the Honorable Judge of the Court:

**Paul Vaughn Haschke**, *Applicant*, furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of **Herbert P. Haschke, Jr.**, *Decedent*, and for issuance of *Letters Testamentary*:

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this estate, domiciled in and residing at 3343 W Carroll Ave., Chicago, Cook County, Illinois 60624. The last three digits of Applicant's Social Security and Illinois driver's license numbers are 563 and 359, respectively.

2. Decedent died on October 9, 2023, at Providence Health Center- Waco, McLennan County, Texas 76712, at the age of 84 years. The last three digits of Decedent's Social Security number and Texas driver's license numbers are 718 and 577, respectively.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent resided in this county at the time of death and Decedent owned property interests in this county.

4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as homestead in Bosque County, Texas, bank accounts, a vehicle, household goods and personal effects of a probable value of less than \$1,000,000.

5. Decedent left a valid, written Will dated November 16, 1982, *the Will*, and a valid written First Codicil To Last Will and Testament dated November 19, 2009 which was never revoked and is filed in this cause.

6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will were John B. Turner, who, at the time of the Will's execution resided near Tulsa, Oklahoma, Marilyn Schooling, who, at the time of the Will's execution resided near Broken Arrow, Oklahoma & Shirley A. Elkins, who, at the time of the Will's execution resided near Tulsa, Oklahoma.

The subscribing witnesses to the Codicil were Nancy A. Pascoe, who, at the time of the Codicil's execution resided near Oologah, Oklahoma and Timothy E. Houchin, who, at the time of the Codicil's execution resided near Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

The Will and Codicil were self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. Decedent was married only once and then to Ann Lee Haschke, which ended in divorce in about 1981 in Dallas County, Texas and now deceased in February of 2021, Dallas County, Texas. Of this marriage, only two children were born:

**Paul Vaughn Haschke**, now an adult, residing at 3343 W Carroll Ave., Chicago, Cook County, Illinois 60624; and

**Theodore Haschke**, now an adult, whose location is unknown to Applicant and has been estranged for about 20 years.

No other child was ever born to Decedent, adopted by Decedent, or taken into Decedent's home with the understanding of adoption.

None of Decedent's marriages were dissolved after the date of the Will.

8. A necessity exists for administration of this estate.

9. Neither Texas, nor any governmental agency of Texas, nor any charitable organization is named in the Will or Codicil as a devisee. The Will's sole beneficiary is Applicant and is Decedent's son.

10. Decedent did not apply for or receive Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005.

11. Decedent's Will named The Trust Company of Oklahoma as the personal representative and Arvest Bank as successor personal representative. Applicant anticipates that The Trust Company of Oklahoma and Arvest Bank will sign a *Waiver of*


*Appointment and Right to Letters Testamentary.* Applicant would serve without bond or other security as Independent Executor, and would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting *Letters Testamentary*, and would be entitled to such Letters.

12. Decedent's Will (paragraph IV.1) grants the Independent Executor full power and authority over Decedent's assets, including the power to sell, manage and dispose of Decedent's property.

13. Pursuant to *Texas Estates Code Section 256.052(b)*, no information required for this Application has been omitted.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that *Letters Testamentary* be issued to Applicant; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
