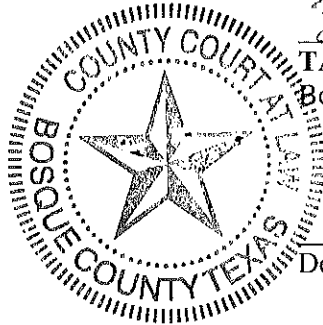

16. *Time Between Date of Death and Application*


