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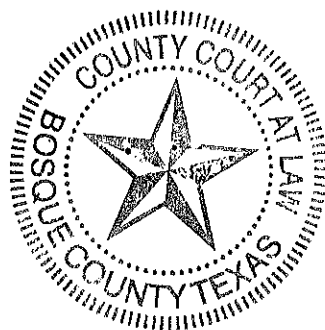

APPLICATION TO PROBATE WILL AND

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Stephen Wayne Harrison and Charles M. Mapes, III ("Applicants"), furnishes the following information to the Court in support of this Application for the probate of the written Will of Mary Lou Crawford ("Decedent"), and for issuance of Letters Testamentary:

2. Decedent died on January 13, 2024, at Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634, at the age of 95 years. Decedent's domicile at the time of his death was Sunset Home, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas.
