TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Rosemarie Thompson Hudson, (“Applicant”) furnishes the following information for the probate of the Will of Gus Hudson, Jr., (“Decedent”) and for issuance of letters testamentary to Applicant.

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this estate, domiciled in, and residing at 320 West 3rd Street, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634, the physical address at which service can be had on applicant. The last three numbers of Applicant’s Texas driver’s license number are 458 and the last three numbers of Applicant’s Social Security number are 647.

2. Decedent died on July 6, 2022, in Clifton, Bosque County, Texas at the age of 84 years. The last three numbers of Decedent’s driver’s license number are 485 and the last three numbers of Decedent’s Social Security number are 853.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence in Bosque County, Texas on the date of death.

4. Decedent owned personal and real property described generally as a home, cash, household goods, and personal effects of the probable value more than \$100,000.00.

5. Decedent left a valid Will (“Will”) dated November 11, 2003, which was never revoked and will be delivered to the Clerk of the Court as required by statute.

6. The names of the subscribing witnesses to the Will are Alice, R. Hernandez, 5144 Ruxtan Lane, Dallas, Texas 75214, and Nancy E, Matheny, 8215 Southwestern Blvd. #11017, Dallas, Texas 75206. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.

8. After the date of Decedent's Will no marriage of Decedent was dissolved.

9. A necessity exists for the administration of this estate.

10. The Will named Applicant to serve without bond or other security as independent executrix and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting letters testamentary, and Applicant would be entitled to such letters.


11. The Will did not name either the State of Texas, a governmental agency of the State of Texas, or a charitable organization as a devisee.
