

- b. that the Will be admitted to probate;
- c. that Applicant be appointed and issued Letters Testamentary as independent executrix of Decedent's estate;
- d. that the Court make all other orders determined necessary or appropriate; and
- e. that Applicant receive all additional legal and equitable relief which Applicant may be entitled to receive.
