
All persons interested in said estate are hereby cited to appear before said Honorable Court at said above mentioned time and place by filing a written answer contesting such application should they desire to do so.



TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Matthew William Dermanoski ("Applicant"), furnishes the following information to the Court in support of this Application for the probate of the Will of John Paul Dermanoski, Jr. ("Decedent"), and for issuance of Letters Testamentary:

1. Applicant, Matthew William Dermanoski, is an individual interested in this Estate, being domiciled in and residing in South Carolina. Matthew William Dermanoski's address for service of citation is 311 Legends Club Drive, Mount Pleasant, South Carolina 29466. The last three digits of the social security number of Matthew William Dermanoski are 427. The last three digits of the driver's license number of Matthew William Dermanoski are 160.

2. Decedent died on November 20, 2023, at Baylor Scott and White Medical Center, Temple, Bell County, Texas, at the age of 76 years. Decedent's domicile at the time of his death was 2095 FM 1238, Iredell, Bosque County, Texas. The last three digits of the social security number of Decedent are 075. The last three digits of the driver's license number of Decedent are 214.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue is proper because Decedent was domiciled in Texas and had a fixed place of residence in this County on the date of his death.

4. Decedent owned property described generally as real estate, cash, personal effects and household goods of a probable value in excess of \$100,000.00.

5. Decedent left a valid Will dated May 17, 2013, which was never revoked.

6. A true and correct copy of the Will is attached. The Will will be delivered to the County Clerk pursuant to the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.

7. A necessity exists for the administration of the Estate.

8. After the date of the Will, no child was born to or adopted by Decedent.

9. A marriage of the Decedent to Karen Signe Dermanoski was dissolved after the will was made, by divorce in August of 2014.

10. Decedent's Will named Karen Signe Dermanoski to serve as Independent Executor to act independently. Karen Signe Dermanoski will decline to serve as Independent Executor. Decedent's Will named Matthew William Dermanoski to serve as successor Independent Executor to act independently. Matthew William Dermanoski resides in Mount Pleasant, Charleston County, South Carolina. Matthew William Dermanoski has not been convicted of any felony or otherwise disqualified from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary and is entitled to such letters.

11. Because Executor Matthew William Dermanoski resides in South Carolina, he has appointed Darby Cole Dermanoski, who resides at 1038 E 43rd Street, Austin, Travis County, Texas 78751, as the resident agent.

12. No state, governmental agency of the state, nor charitable organization is named by the Will as a devisee.

13. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law and the subscribing witnesses to the Will are Connie S. Lee and Anita Adams.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to Matthew Dermanoski; and that all other Orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
